## Acapulco: Paradise of the Mexican Riviera

*Wrapped around the wide crescent-shaped Acapulco Bay, world-famous, sun-drenched Acapulco is a scenic resort paradise replete with blue sea, white beaches, green hills, rugged cliffs and sun-worshippers from around the world.*

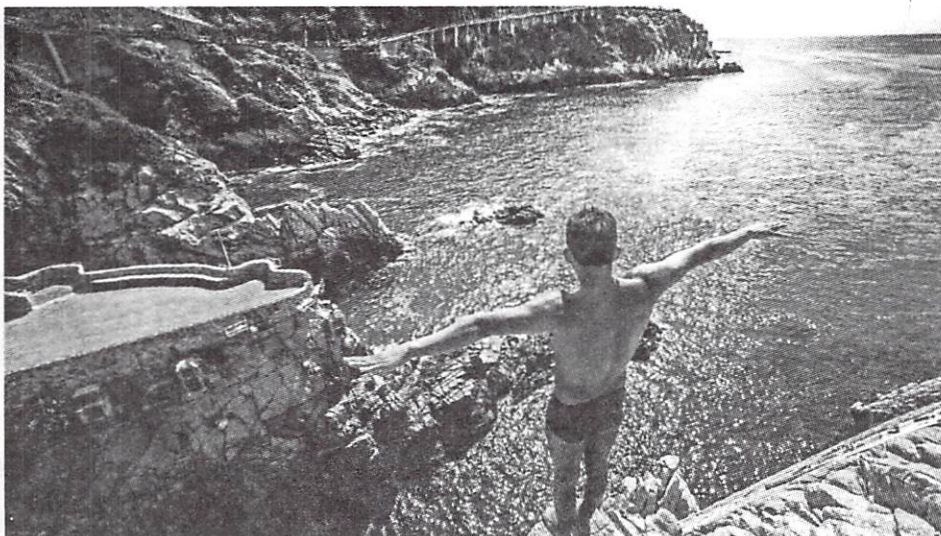
### Brief History

Although the Acapulco area was settled in very early times, the name first appears in the records only after the Aztec conquest at the end of the 15th century. Ancient vessels from Peru may also have reached the region

centuries before recorded history. The first European to discover the bay was the Spanish conquistador Gil Gonzales Avila in 1521.

In the years to follow, Acapulco became a supply base for expeditions along the Pacific coast to North and South

America, and by the end of the 16th century, Acapulco was the home port for the Spanish galleons which carried on trade with the Philippines, China, India and South America. The goods brought into Acapulco were then transported by land to Mexico City, and from there to Veracruz on the Gulf of Mexico, from which they were shipped to Spain.

In the 17th and 18th centuries, the shipping routes from Acapulco, like other seaways in those days, were often exposed to pirates. The decline of the port began when a new trade route – from East Asia and around Africa's Cape of Good Hope to Spain – was opened up at the end of the 18th century.

After Mexico finally achieved its independence from Spain in 1821, Acapulco lost all importance. It wasn't until the construction of a new road linking it with Mexico City in 1927 that the town began to revive. The boom years began when it was discovered by American tourists after World War II.

### **Acapulco Today**

Acapulco is now a city of more than 800,000 permanent residents, with over 500 hotels and resorts, and the most visitors of any Mexican coastal city (well over four million yearly). Its visitor attractions are divided between those for the foreigners and those for the many Mexican citizens who swell the winter population of this favorite resort city.

Acapulco is still a veritable paradise, in spite of the heavy tourist traffic. The area has retained its exotic, natural beauty and steps have been taken to guarantee its preservation.

The center of town and its zócalo (main square), often referred to as "traditional" Acapulco, are on the western

side of the Bay, where you will find the Cathedral, a Moorish-Byzantine styled church built in the 1930s. Near the port is Fort San Diego which was built in 1616 to protect the port from Dutch and English pirates; it is now a regional history museum.

The seaside promenade, Malecón, meanders along the water's edge, past much of the city's activity. The most fascinating place in town is the Public Market, with a wide variety of merchants selling their wares. The resort life is concentrated along the palm tree-lined Avenida Costera Miguel Alemán, where most of the hotels, restaurants, night spots and shops are clustered.

### **La Quebrada Cliff Divers**

Beyond the Malecón is the hilly peninsula that shelters the harbor. The first big hotels and expensive houses were built on its slopes. Across the peninsula is La Quebrada, an observation point over the rocky cliffs of the town's seaward side. At the end of La Quebrada stands El Mirador Hotel, where you can relax at the bar and watch the sunset, and stay on for a good view of Acapulco's famous high divers.

These clavadistas perform their death-defying dives in the early afternoon on most days, and often at night off the spectacular flood-lighted rocks. Intrepid young men step onto a ledge just below the Mirador's terraces, raise their arms dramatically, and dive into the sea, 150 feet below.

Each dive must be perfectly timed to coincide with an incoming wave, or the diver risks being crushed on the jagged rocks. There is no trick to the feat, nor is any of these dare-devils faking it. After each dive, the hero emerges from the

sea with much fanfare, appreciative applause and hopefully a plethora of pesos as tips from onlookers, who can sit on the El Mirador Terrace, at the hotel's La Perla nightclub, or pay a small admission and get closer. Regardless of the vantage point, this breathtaking spectacle should be witnessed at least once.

### **Daytime Diversions**

There are plenty of local sights, beaches and shopping in this bustling Mexican resort town. There are also plenty of sun-worshippers, so if your idea of the perfect visit to Acapulco includes some time at the seashore, go early to stake out your area on the busy beach; don't forget your sun-block! (And remember: when confronted by the hordes of hawkers, the polite response is no, gracias.)

## Acapulco, Mexico Arrival Information

Crystal Serenity is scheduled to dock in the port of Acapulco, Mexico, at the Terminal Maritima at 8:00am today, Wednesday, January 17, 2018. An announcement is made as soon as the ship has been cleared by local authorities.

When going ashore, please remember to carry your **Guest Identification Key Card** as you must show it to the officer at the gangway when exiting and re-boarding Crystal Serenity. In addition, local authorities require that guests also have a **government issued I.D.** with them as well.

**Please note: No food, fruit or plants may be taken ashore due to local Agriculture and Quarantine regulations.**

The terminal building contains souvenir shops and tourist information.

Taxis are usually available outside the terminal building and are not metered. It is recommended to agree on a price before beginning your trip. Taxis will also only accept cash.

The local currency is the Mexican Peso (MXN). 1 US dollar = 19.62 MXN. US dollars are widely accepted.

If you have items that you would prefer not to lose, you may wish to consider leaving them on the ship.

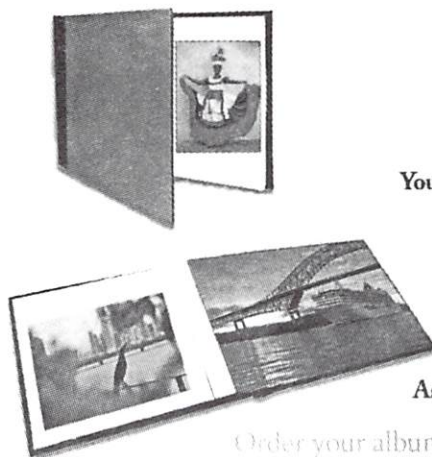

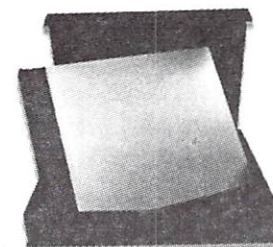

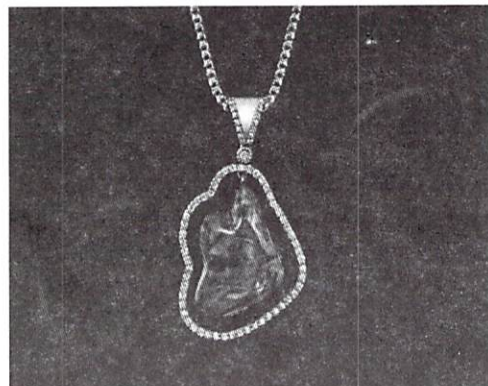

## PERSONALITY PROFILE

### Concert Pianist Tian Jiang

Since his acclaimed debut at Carnegie Hall in 1989, Tian Jiang has become recognized as one of the first virtuoso pianists to emerge from the People's Republic of China after the stark years of the Cultural Revolution. Praised for his "Shining, crisp, energetic and



colorfully illuminated playing" by *The New York Times*, a subsequent profile on CBS's "Sunday Morning" with Charles Kuralt further celebrated the sweet irony of this remarkable artist's rich, imaginative interpretations: that this music he had been forbidden to hear, let alone play as a child, had become his life.

He first came to international attention when he appeared with Vladimir Ashkenazy in a BBC film about his historic visit to China in 1980. In 1981, Tian was one of the five young musicians chosen by Issac Stern to come to the US and take part in the first cultural exchange program between the United States and China. He studied at the San Francisco Conservatory of Music with Mack McCray, The Manhattan School of Music with Constance Keene, and the Juilliard School with Peter Serkin as well as privately with Eugene List.

Tian's extraordinary gifts brought him numerous honors including winning the William Kappell International Piano Competition and the prestigious Van Cliburn Award. In 1995 he joined the famed CAMI (Columbia Artists management) roster as the first mainland Chinese concert pianist.

His break came in 1998, when substituting for Arcadi Volodos at the Gala Concert in Kenan Auditorium of North Carolina playing all Mozart's program. Tian became an overnight success and the invitations started to pour in.

Captivating audiences from North America to South Africa, Europe to the Far East, he has been enthusiastically received in concerto appearances with the London Symphony Orchestra, The Vienna Mozart Symphony Orchestra, The Moscow Philharmonic Orchestra, The Los Angeles Philharmonic, The Boston Pop, The Orchestra of St. Luke's, The Hong Kong Philharmonic Orchestra, The Shanghai Symphony Orchestra, and The National Philharmonic of China. He has collaborated with conductors such as Zubin Mehta, Daniele Gatti, Ettore Stratta, Gerald Schwartz. In recital, he has performed throughout the world.

As a Mozart interpreter, Daniel Cariaga in the *Los Angeles Times* characterized Tian's playing as "A deeply persuasive Mozartean" saying that "Tian Jiang achieved an exquisite performance who delivers the full spectrum of the composer's virtues – wit, pathos, brilliance, and serenity in this buoyant performance." As the first Chinese pianist to have toured his homeland with the Royal Philharmonic Orchestra on its historic visit to China in 2000, The Royal Philharmonic Orchestra's in house magazine praised: "Tian played superbly".

Tian's tireless energy and boundless drive to attract new audiences to classical music have brought him to a wide range of music audiences. Thinking "outside the box" and frequent steps into different musical worlds, he has shared the same stage with the legendary Philip Glass, and plays concerts at the prestigious Carnegie Hall and the Sydney Opera House, as well as a special performance at the Jerry Lewis Telethon – "Stars Across America" and in the Galaxy Lounge of Crystal Cruises ships.

As a recording artist, Tian has 12 albums to his credit. His original composition "Shanghai Dream" has been heralded by the World Music Reviews as "...a slice of heaven." Since it was first released by Global Beat Record, the recording caused a sensation. It instantly became one of the top classical crossover best-sellers, and was listed on the *Bill Board* magazine, as well as profiled on the CNN's "Entertainment News" and NPR's "All Things Are Considered." Until this day, more than 450,000 copies of "Shanghai Dream" have been sold worldwide.

Tian's recent headlining China concerts with celebrated violinist Alexander Markov were filled to capacity and his upcoming engagements are scheduled in the USA, Germany, Russia, South Africa, and China.
