## U.S. immigration and Customs Formalities

On the morning of our arrival at Brooklyn Cruise Terminal, US Customs and Border Protection will be inspecting all Queen Mary 2 guests regardless of nationality and final disembarkation date. The inspection will be carried out in the terminal building. Guests are kindly requested to follow the immigration instructions that were delivered to your stateroom.

Please be advised that you will not be allowed to return to the ship until all guests have attended the immigration inspection. However, if you are not intending to go ashore for the day, please proceed to the Terminal when the final announcement is made, which is expected to be at approximately 10.00am. Once you have cleared the inspection, you may proceed to the Embarkation Hall where there is seating available. You will be advised when you are allowed to re-board Queen Mary 2.

### You are required to present the following at the inspection:

**PASSPORT:** All guests regardless of nationality are required to present a passport to the Immigration Officials, this includes US and Canadian Citizens. If you hold a Green Card/ARC card or belong to one of the Visa Waiver Programme countries - ESTA, these are required documents to be presented at immigration.

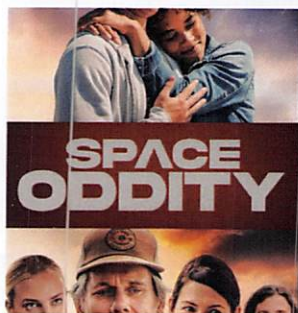

### Assembly Station familiarisation

It is a maritime requirement that all guests attend their Assembly Station for familiarisation purposes. If you have not already done so, please visit your Assembly Station where your Voyage card will be scanned to record your attendance. Your allocated Assembly Station is as indicated on the back of your stateroom door, boarding pass and Voyage card. There is no need to take your life jacket with you. We ask that all guests watch the Cunard safety video on their stateroom television, channel 23.

### Luggage delivery

Your luggage will be delivered directly to your stateroom/suite. Please be aware that this process takes a considerable amount of time and we ask for your patience and understanding. It is not unusual for bags within the same party to be separated so please do not be alarmed if only some of your luggage pieces arrive. Please report any luggage problems to the Purser's Office.

### Alcohol Policy

Guests who are under 18 years of age are not permitted to purchase or consume alcohol on board. However, while in U.S. waters, Cunard enforces and abides by the U.S. legal drinking age of 21 years.

### How to keep healthy on board

So as to limit your chances of becoming unwell, we recommend you take the following precautionary measures: • Social distancing should be practiced throughout your holiday. We'll make this as easy as possible, with signs and crew to guide you. • Wear a face mask when moving around indoors and when seated in Illuminations, the Royal Court Theatre, Casino and when using the Gym. • Wash your hands often and use hand sanitiser when hand-washing facilities are not available. • Cough or sneeze into a tissue or bent elbow, and not into your hands; throw used tissues in the bin and wash your hands afterwards. • Avoid contact with anyone you know who is unwell and their close contacts. • Remain vigilant and report any COVID-19 symptoms to the Medical team by dialling 999 or 911.

### Britannia Restaurant seating enquiries

The Britannia Restaurant, Deck 3 entrance, will be open from 1.30pm to 3.00pm for seating enquiries. A seating card will be placed in your stateroom or suite during embarkation. Kindly note that table assignments have been allocated by the fare type and the date you booked your voyage; the Maitre d'Hôtel will be following the company policy. Please refer to your booking terms and conditions. Guests who have selected Early or Late Dining are kindly asked to use the Britannia Restaurant Deck 2 (lower level) only. Should you wish to join guests on the Open Dining during your voyage, please inform the Maitre d'Hôtel in advance. Guests who have selected Open Dining are politely requested to use only the Britannia Restaurant Deck 3 (Upper level) during dinner service.

### South Brooklyn Ferry Service

New York Ferry operates a ferry service from Red Hook Cruise Terminal. The Red Hook Atlantic Basin stop is part of the South Brooklyn route. It only takes approximately 20 minutes to reach Wall Street Pier 11. From there you may continue on the Soundview route further up on the East River e.g. to the East 34th Street stop in Midtown Manhattan. One way ticket fare is US\$4.00. **Departures from Red Hook in the morning:** 7.22am, 8.20am, 9.10am, 10.00am and 11.12am. The ride is direct on the first 4 departures mentioned above and takes only 10 minutes, the ride on the 11.12am departure will be 19 minutes. **Departures from Wall Street Pier 11 back to Red Hook in the afternoon:** 1.08pm, 1.52pm, 2.36pm and 3.20pm. The return ride is 17 minutes.
